- Pre-squad options: SOSClays Premium Member (\$60/year; pre-squad all SOSClays events at no charge) or pay-per-post (\$2 per post per shooter, paid to SOSClays).
- When a Premium Member squads others, the Premium Member is free; non-Premium members \$2 fees are collected at cashiering.

Each option played is an entry into the shoot off drawing. For example: 2 events have the option, and the shooter plays the option on 2 events, they will have 2 entries into the drawing for the shootout.

Shooters must select and pay for the \$10.00 option, prior to the start of the event.

At the end of the last event having the option, 20 qualifying participants names will be randomly drawn for the shootout. You must be in attendance to participate in the shootout. Shooters names will be posted on the scoreboard. .

Each entry from playing the option is only good for the drawing and Saturday shootout. Shootout participants will shoot TWO (2) targets at each post for a total of ten (10) targets from the shooter's Official yardage (yardage as of that day). Shoot off rounds will consist of ten (10) targets. Shoot off rounds will continue until a winner and second place are determined. Decisions made by shoot management regarding the above listed rules, or other disputes, shall be final.

1. Shells will not be available for sale at the club, so be sure to bring what you may need.
2. If you desire to save your empty hulls, please transfer them from your gun to your pouch. Picking up empty hulls from the ground during and after shooting will not be permitted.
3. Resident winners of the Championship Events are asked to have their photos taken when picking up their trophies for submittal to Trap & Field.

TARGETS & SETTINGS

White Flyer Black Rim targets will be thrown for this tournament. Shoot Management will set all targets. Questions concerning target settings will be referred to Shoot Management; its decisions are final.

NO EXCEPTIONS

No soliciting, selling or distribution of shot, shells or any types of goods or wares are allowed on the club premises without the permission of CPRC. Violators will be removed from premises.

REGISTRATION/PRACTICE

1. Coast Rifle and Pistol Club will open for registration and practice at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday May 20, 2026. Club House will be open from 6:00 am until 9:00pm each day of the shoot. The Office will open at 7:00 a.m. daily throughout the shoot.
2. **The program will begin promptly at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday May 21, and 8:30 a.m. on all other days.**
3. Practice is restricted to before and after the events.

ATTENDANCE / AWARD PINS

MTA will give attendance pins to each shooter that participates in the 2026 Mississippi State Trap shoot.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

ANNOUNCEMENT

This program will absolutely govern the Tournament. The Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern all points not otherwise provided herein. **Shoot Management reserves the right, in its sole discretion, at any time prior to, or during this Tournament to change or modify the program in any manner it deems necessary.**

DISQUALIFICATION

Management reserves the right to refuse any entry or disqualify anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of this shoot in any manner.

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES

CRPC will be open at 7:00 a.m. each day. Program shooting
will begin at 9:30 a.m. Thursday and 8:30 a.m. Friday-Saturday
-Sunday

1. This tournament will begin Thursday, May 21, 2026.
 - a. Events 1 through 6 will feature a Resident and Non-Resident Champion but all other awards are open.
 - b. Events 7 through 11 will feature Resident and Non-Resident awards.
 - c. Events 7 through 9 will be the Mississippi Championship events featuring awards for Resident and Non-Resident winners.
2. Daily fees: ATA-\$4.00, MTA-\$4.00.
3. Program targets will be \$45.00 per 100. Practice targets will be \$7.00 per 25 for singles or handicap and \$7.00 per 12 pair of doubles.
4. **Entry fees shall be paid in cash or by personal checks.** The cashier will not accept counter checks, second party checks, or credit cards. **No exceptions.**
5. There are no compulsory purses.
7. Coast Rifle and Pistol Club opens Wednesday, May 20th from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm for pre-registration, squadding and practice.
8. **Pre-Squadding**—Please **see Page 3** of this program for pre-squadding instructions. **It is highly recommended to PreSquad otherwise you may find events filled.** You may not be able to register if not pre-squadded. PreSquadding opens March 15, 2026 and closes May 20, 2026. PreSquad at SOSClays.com—**See Page 3.**
9. **All SQUADDING and RESQUADDING shall close 30 minutes prior to the event.**
10. Upon entry, a competitor must complete said event in order to qualify for any associated trophy or prizes.
11. In Events where Handicap is divided into yardages: 19-21.5 shall be Short Yardage; 22-24.5 shall be Mid-Yardage and 25 -27 shall be Long Yardage.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Before leaving the registration table, check your Entry Sheet for correct classification, handicap yardage and Special Categories (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sr. Veteran, Veteran, Sub Vet, Junior, Sub-Junior, Junior Gold, Chair Shooter). **It is your responsibility to know the rules.** You are subject to penalties for shooting in the wrong classification or wrong yardage.
2. It is the responsibility of Special Category shooters to insure they are so designated on their entry cards and on the bulletin board score sheets. Report any omission to the shoot management.
3. You may use your own shells including reloads. All shells and reloads must meet ATA specifications and rules. If you wish to keep your hulls transfer them from the gun to your bag. Once hulls are on the ground please leave them there.
4. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on any one event if he or she missed their squad. If you are unable to join your squad before they have started their third post, you must re-squad. All make-ups for either missed squads or gun repairs must report to the Handicap Committee prior to when the last squad takes the line for that particular event.
5. **This shoot will be governed by current ATA Rules. By entering the competition, every person agrees to accept all official decisions and to abide by the ATA rules.**
6. Please check your score after firing at each post. The squad leader (No. 1 shooter) will total the scores for each member of the squad after 25 targets and initial the score sheets. Errors made in totaling will be corrected when discovered. However, all changes in lost or dead targets will be made in the strict accordance with ATA rules.

Shoot Management will make all program interpretations

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1) Should you win your class in any preliminary 16 yard singles event, or in any doubles event, or earn yardage in any handicap event, it shall be your duty to report to the handicap table and have your yardage or classification reviewed. Any Shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason shall be considered to have been notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin board.
- 2) Any Shooter failing to carry out Rule 1, or who shoots in a class or a yardage marked higher or lower than that which is marked on their card, will be subject to penalty and will not be eligible to share any money division or trophy whatsoever.
- 3) No Shooter may win more than one trophy or prize money in the same event. Trophy priority shall be determined by shoot management and/or applicable ATA rules
- 4) Each Shooter who is entitled to receive money won during any event agrees that all checks in payment for the money won will be mailed to him at the address indicated by ATA records, and when so mailed, the Club will not be liable in any manner whatsoever for any check lost, stolen, unclaimed, undelivered or otherwise not received by the shooter. Checks are considered void after 90 days.
- 5) Hearing and eye protection is required at all times when forward of the benches and on the field. Only shooters and officials are allowed on the field, Violations by non-participants may result in removal.
- 6) **NO ENTRIES REFUNDED UNLESS EVENT IS CANCELLED**

Shoot Management will make all program interpretations and reserves the right to modify this program at any time as necessary.

Trophies will not be mailed.

Rules and Regulation Continued

- 7) Champions and ties: Champions and ties, class winners and ties in Warmup Singles and Doubles will not advance in subsequent events. Class winners and ties in Preliminary Singles and Doubles events will advance one class for the remainder of subsequent events in the program.
- 8) Shooters should have an up to date ATA Average Card at registration.
- 9) The State Handicap Champion will automatically earn a minimum of one yard.
- 10) Events will be shot on a 1 Field Bank System (100 targets per field).
- 11) Field assignment will be rotated after each event. It is the shooters responsibility to periodically check the board for Squad/Field Assignments.

SHOOT-OFFS

Shoot Management will oversee and referee all shoot-offs. Shoot Management decisions are final.

All Shooters that tie in warm-up or preliminary singles or doubles events will have the tie carry over into the following like event until resolved. Ties for Championship Singles (Event 7) and any remaining singles event carry over will shoot off on Saturday. Championship Doubles ties (Event 8) and any remaining doubles event carryover will be determined by shoot-offs on Sunday. All handicap event ties will be determined in shoot-offs the day of the event. There will be three (3) — five (5) minute calls. Contestants will be called, First Call, Second Call, and Final Call for shoot-offs. No response, shooters will forfeit. All singles & handicap shoot-offs will be on a 25 target basis and doubles will be on 10 pairs. HAA and HOA ties will be resolved by reverse scores.

CATEGORY SHOOTERS

In this program, a Sub-Junior is any shooter who has not reached his or her 15th birthday. A Junior is any shooter who is 15 but has not reached 18 years of age. A Junior Gold is any shooter who is 18 but has not reached 23 years of age. A Sub Veteran is a shooter who is 55 but has not reached 65 years of age. A Veteran is a shooter 65 through 69 years of age. A Senior Veteran is a Shooter 70 years of age or older. A Lady I is a female who has not reached 55 years of age. A Lady II is a female 55 and older. New ATA rulings apply.

All events will be awarded All American points. Shooters may declare only one category (i.e. Lady I or Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran). Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry-over for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the championship trophy shoot-off/carry-over and has declared a special category at the time of classification, the shooter will fall back to the declared category.

Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score qualifies for any trophy in his/her declared category, will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class, or yardage group.

Any special category shooter, whose score does not qualify for a trophy in his/her Category, may compete for place, class or yardage group trophies. Once any declaration has been made either by a shooter or shoot management the declaration is final and can not be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.

All Lady I & Lady II, Sub - Juniors, Juniors, Junior Gold, Sub-Veterans, Veterans, And Senior - Vets must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy for the duration after firing his/her first shot.

MISSISSIPPI TRAPSHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIPS

Singles & Doubles Classifications

All shooters will be classified on known ability and/or their 16-yard and doubles averages as follows:

SINGLES (Five Classes)

97% and over..... AA
94% and under 97..... A
91% and under 94..... B
88% and under 91..... C
under 88%..... D

DOUBLES (Five Classes)

93% and over..... AA
89% and under 93%..... A
85% and under 89%..... B
78% and under 85%..... C
under 78%..... D

Shooters who do not have a total of 1,000 16 yard targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous year combined shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the handicap committee.

Shooters who do not have a total of 500 Doubles targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous year combined shall be placed in Class B or higher at the discretion of the Handicap Committee

HANDICAP CLASSIFICATION

Shooters who do not have a total of 1,000 Handicap targets registered with the ATA combined in the current and previous year will be assigned 2-yard penalty up to 25-yards max or their regular handicap yardage, whichever is greater. Handicap target requirements will be waived for shooters age 70 and over, making them eligible for trophies and monies. Any participant who fails to meet the minimum handicap target requirements as described will be allowed the choice of shooting "Targets Only" from their assigned yardage provided they waive and forfeit all rights to options, purses, added money, and trophies including HOA and HAA trophies.

All targets shot on Warmup and Preliminary days may be applied toward above target requirements. If target requirement is met, **you** must immediately return to the Handicap Desk and be re-classified. If requirements are not met, you will remain shooting assigned yardage and/or assigned classification. No targets will be credited for target minimums after preliminary day.

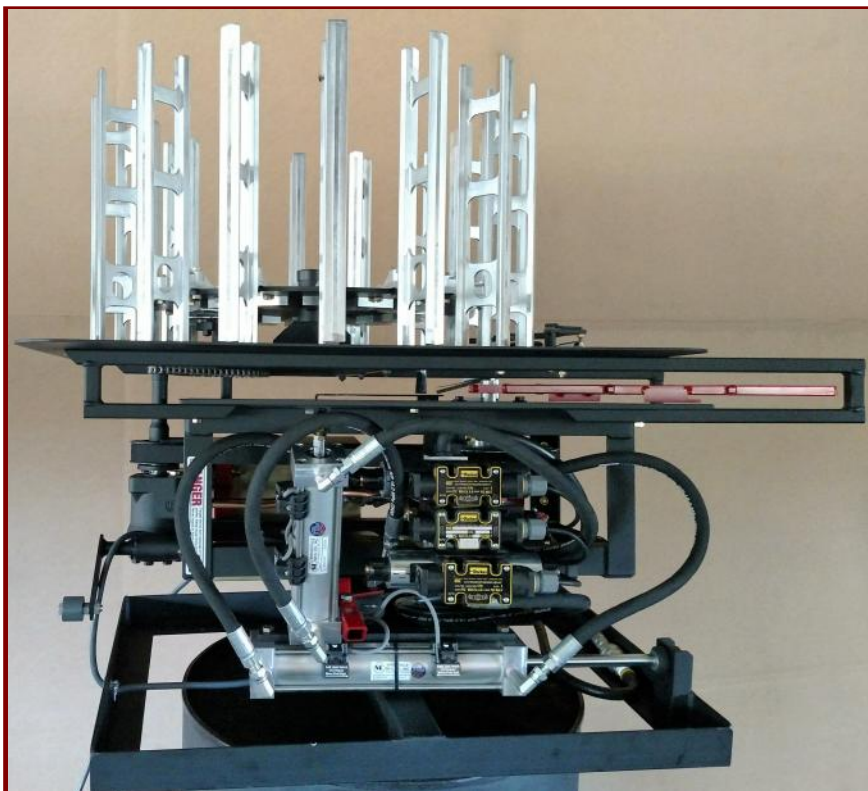

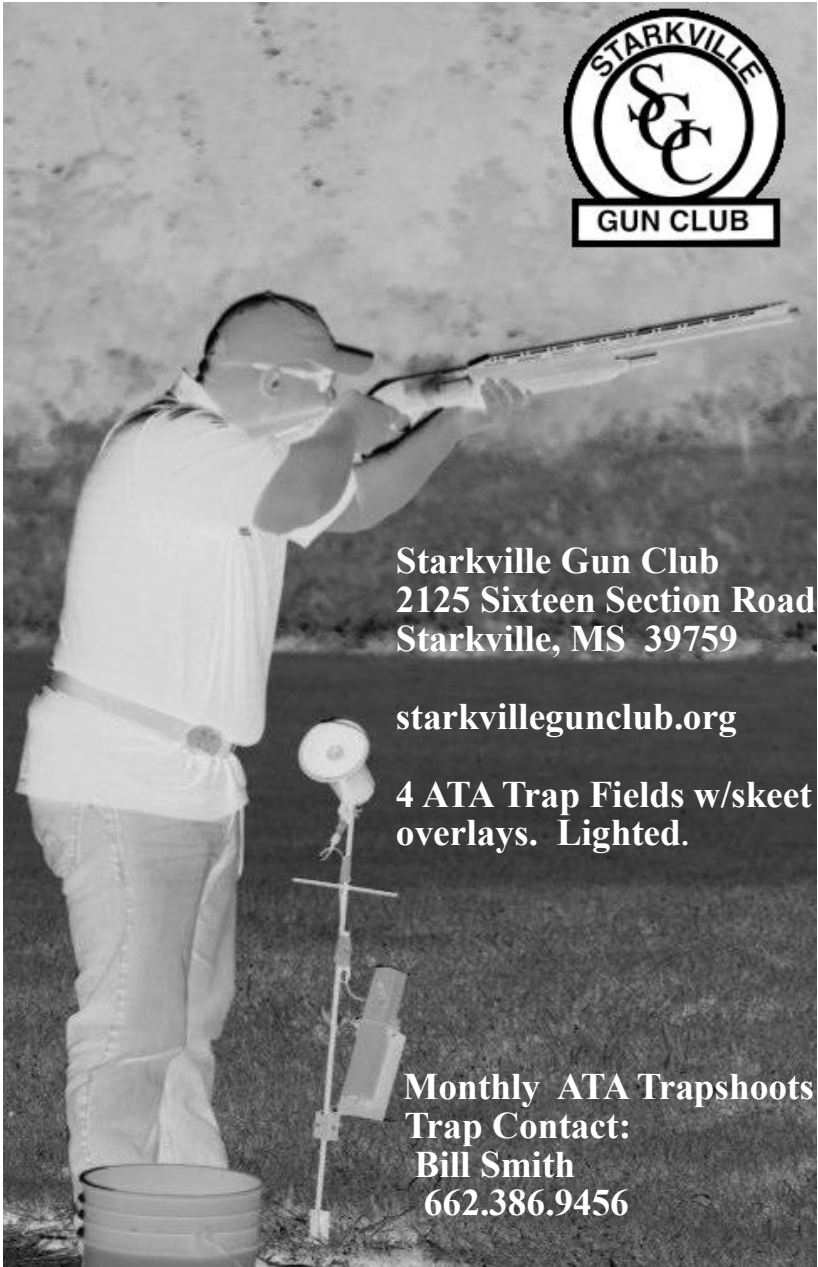

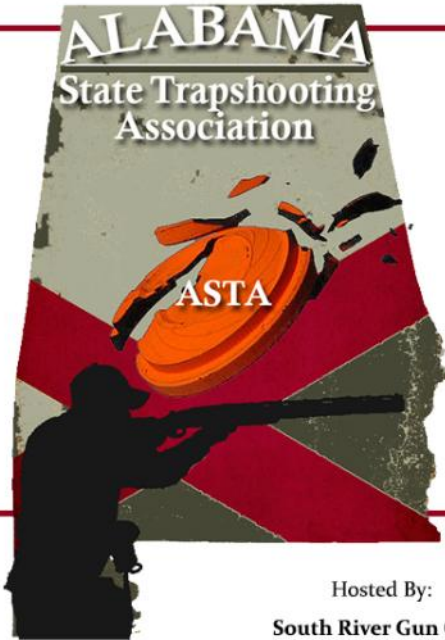
